The Wyoming Department of Public Safety is scheduled for an on-site assessment as part of a program to achieve reaccreditation by verifying that it meets professional standards.

Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA), the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services.

As part of the on-site assessment, agency employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a public information session on Tuesday, November 4, 2014, from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. The session will be conducted in the Wyoming Department of Public Safety Headquarters Building located at 2300 DeHoop Avenue SW, Wyoming, Michigan.

Agency employees and the public are also invited to offer comments by calling (616)530-7313 on Tuesday, November 4, 2014 between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. Members of the assessment team will take comments.

Telephone comments, as well as appearances at the public information session, are limited to 5 minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with CALEA's standards.
