Accepted Items (FREE)

- Computers, Printers, Copiers, Monitors, Keyboards, Speakers, Mice, Cables
- TVs, VCRs, Radios, Stereo Equipment, Tape Recorders, Record Players
- Telephones, PBX Systems, Answering Machines, Wire, Aluminum
- Networking Equipment, Hubs, Switches, Routers
- Video Recorders, Security Systems
- CB Radios, Cell Phones, Pagers, PDAs
- Walkman, Cash Registers, Typewriters, Adding Machines, Calculators
- Software, CDROM/Floppy Disc, Cables, Cords, UPSs, Surge Strips
- Scanners, Digital Cameras, MP3 Players
- Rechargeable Batteries, Racks/Carts
- Lab and Hospital devices and test equipment
(excluding any equipment/devices that contain fluids, oil, or radioactive material)

Unaccepted Items

- Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs) or any equipment containing PCBs
- Microwaves, Thermostats, Smoke Detectors
- Small kitchen appliances
- Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers or any unit containing Freon
- Stoves, Washer/Dryers, Garbage Compactors, Dishwashers, Kitchen white goods
- Household Batteries, other than installed in equipment
- Light Bulbs, Ballasts
- Furniture
- Lab/Hospital equipment/devices that contain fluids, oil, radioactive material
- Biohazards—for example, medical waste including any needles
