Dear Mr. Kent:

This letter is in response to your submittal of a RMP modification request to the Water Bureau, Grand Rapids District Office, received on August 6, 2008, with additional information submitted on September 25, 2008, for biosolids generated at the City of Wyoming Clean Water Plant (CWP), Kent County, Michigan.

Your RMP modification has been reviewed and is hereby approved.

You are authorized to land apply biosolids in accordance with the conditions found in the Wyoming CWP RMP. This authorization is conditioned upon the issuance of your National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit authorizing biosolids application. By this authorization, the City of Wyoming shall also comply with the standards and requirements contained in 40 CFR Part 503 of Federal Law and Part 24 Land Application of Biosolids, of Administrative Rules promulgated pursuant to Part 31 of 1994 PA 451, as amended in Michigan Law.

This authorization shall immediately be revoked if: (a) either the NPDES permit or RMP is revoked; (b) application for an NPDES permit is denied; (c) there is any change in the chemical composition of the biosolids that cause them to no longer be acceptable for land application; (d) the permittee or any contractor or subcontractor fails to comply with the aforementioned terms and conditions of this approval; (e) additional information indicates the biosolids are no longer acceptable for land application or are causing environmental contamination; or (f) new state or federal regulations are promulgated which would cause this authorization to be invalid.

Adverse environmental impacts resulting from the use of land application sites are subject to the enforcement provisions of Parts 17, 31, 55, 111, 115, and 201 of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act (NREPA), 1994 PA 451, as amended, and other applicable state and federal laws.


