The Wyoming Police Department is scheduled for an on-site assessment as part of a program to achieve accreditation by verifying that it meets professional standards.

Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA), the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services.

As part of the on-site assessment, agency employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a public information session on Monday, January 23, 2012 at 5:30 p.m. The session will be conducted in the Wyoming City Hall Council Chambers located at 1155 28th Street SW, Wyoming, Michigan.

Agency employees and the public are also invited to offer comments by calling (616)257-9715 on Tuesday, January 24, 2012 between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. Members of the assessment team will take comments.

Telephone comments, as well as appearances at the public information session, are limited to 10 minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with CALEA's standards.
