## Purpose

The purpose of the Parks and Recreation Commission is to review recreational program and park needs of the community and advise the City Manager and City Council on recommended changes. The Commission also plans and coordinates recreation activities and park development with various school, civic, social, religious and fraternal organizations for the development of a comprehensive and harmonious public and private recreational system and program for the city.

## Commission Members

The Parks and Recreation Commission is made up of eleven members from the community. Members are appointed by the City Council. There are six at-large members and a member is nominated by each of the following school boards: Godwin, Godfrey-Lee, Kelloggsville, Wyoming and Grandville. The City Council may appoint one of its members to the Commission. Members serve a three-year term.
